Procedure:

Your pet has been admitted for an anesthetic procedure today. Please be assured that the Staff at Fairview Hospital for Animals will use the safest anesthetics available and that your pet is constantly monitored throughout the procedure. But regardless of an animal's age or apparent health status, all anesthetic procedures have an element of risk.

A simple blood test, however, can be performed on the day of the procedure that helps to decrease the risk of anesthesia. This test allows us to check the function of internal organs, such as liver and kidneys, and can alert us to some of the more common problems allowing for extra precautions to be taken.

Research has indicated that while pets may appear to withstand pain better than humans, they do, in fact, experience pain to a great degree. While undergoing surgery, your pet will receive anesthetic drugs that prevent pain. Additional medications are available that enable us to safely and effectively control the level of your pet's discomfort after surgery and during their recovery at home. Since we care about your pet's comfort and strongly believe that pain relief is important, we recommend pain management.
